Job Description

Reports to:

Location:

Hybrid - Home and Oxford office attendance for a minimum of two days per week (Tuesday and Wednesday)

Duration & Hours:

Full-time, permanent, 35hrs per week with some flexibility around working pattern.

Job Purpose:

The Individual Giving Fundraising Manager is a new role at Opportunity International UK, you will play a vital role in developing and executing fundraising strategies to support our mission of empowering people to work their way out of poverty. Working within the fundraising team, this role focuses on acquiring new donors, reactivating lapsed supporters, embracing digital approaches, and innovating to create donor experiences that wow and delight. Fostering engagement and long-term relationships you will help maximize income and support our transformative programmes.

Dimensions:

Annual income target of £300k, with a focus on growing and developing this income further to support our international programmes and organisational income needs.

Key Accountabilities, Responsibilities & Tasks:

1. Donor Acquisition and Lead Generation:

- Develop and implement innovative and effective strategies for acquiring new donors and reactivating lapsed supporters to support our mission.
- Research potential fundraising prospects such as individual major and mid-level donors (in accordance with the privacy policy) and work to identify leads at all levels.



- Deploy innovative solutions, acquisition channels, and lead generation activities to build effective donor recruitment pipelines at all levels.
- Utilise data-driven approaches to identify potential donor segments and create personalised outreach plans.
- Develop strategies to convert email leads to financial supporters, supporting our mission to empower communities globally.

2. Individual Giving Programme Management:

- Plan and lead an integrated Individual Giving programme to drive growth in net income, supporter retention, and lifetime value.
- Design and execute creative fundraising campaigns across multiple channels, ensuring timely delivery within budget.
- Manage the production of annual fundraising appeals, including strategic campaigns to support key projects and initiatives in developing countries.
- Coordinate project teams for campaigns, ensuring compelling propositions and effective data segmentation.
- Drive income from regular donors through existing and new initiatives and explore new opportunities to enhance regular giving.

3. Event Activities

 Support and coordinate fundraising events, including HRH The Princess Royal (Patron) events, donor engagement dinners and events, and donor Insight trips to see OIUK's programmes.

4. Internal Collaboration:

- Collaborate with the communications team to develop engaging marketing materials for online and offline campaigns.
- Work closely with colleagues across the organisation to integrate supporter engagement efforts and maximize opportunities for impact.
- Act as an ambassador for Opportunity International UK, building networks to enhance voluntary income growth.

5. Supporter Reactivation & Stewardship:

- Enhance the supporter experience by developing donor and supporter journeys and leading annual supporter thank you events to deepen engagement.
- Work with the Finance & Database Administrator to ensure donor information is recorded accurately, actions are kept up-to-date, and promote and support the team's use of our CRM.



- Thank donors and supporters in a timely and effective way, aiming to build donor delight and confidence in our organisation.
- Monitor the OIUK general inbox and the fundraising telephone line, managing queries in a professional and timely manner.
- Coordinate and support the Moves Management process in collaboration with the Head of Philanthropy
- Other ad-hoc tasks related to fundraising activity.

6. Planning and Budgets:

- Develop annual budgets and operational plans for Individual and Regular Giving activities
- Monitor activities, adjust forecasts, and take necessary actions to achieve financial targets.

7. External Relationships:

 Maintain excellent working relationships with external suppliers and agencies to ensure high standards and value for money.

8. Compliance and Safety:

- Ensure compliance with fundraising regulations, GDPR, safeguarding, and health & safety standards.
- Report any incidents and complete all mandatory training.

Qualifications, Skills, Experience, and Knowledge:

- Expertise in lead generation, donor acquisition, reactivation, and building long-term relationships with supporters, ideally gained in a charity or not-for-profit.
- Understanding of donor motivation, data analysis, and effective communication strategies.
- Proven track record in managing budgets, meeting income targets, and forecasting.
- Excellent communication skills across various media.
- Empathy and commitment to Opportunity International UK's values, mission and Christian ethos, to empower communities.

Key Personal Attributes:

- Compassionate and confident, with strong emotional resilience.
- Innovative problem solver with the ability to work under pressure.
- Excellent organisational skills, with the ability to manage multiple priorities.



- Ability to work effectively in a small team and a small organisation.
- Willingness to be involved in areas outside the immediate role to aid others.
- Strong interpersonal skills, with the ability to inspire and motivate others.
- Ability to work independently, using initiative within structured timescales.
- Assess reputational risk and seek appropriate advice when needed.
- Ability to consolidate learning quickly and apply it effectively.
